

MARYLAND BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE

If the operator of a boat <u>was born on or after July 1. 1972</u>, the State of MD requires that he or she have a MD Boating Safety License! They are required to have it on them when out driving a boat.

The license is available to take online.

The Safety Certificate is for the rules of the road, safety procedures and information about docking. It does not cover the actual physical, hands-on experience of driving and docking a boat.
